



WESTERN SUBURBS FOOTBALL CLUB THE 2021 WELLINGTON GRADED CHAMPS INFORMATION

- + There will be a coaches' meeting on both Saturday and Sunday morning at 8.30am sharp in the clubrooms. You will be given an information pack which will include your team cards which need to be returned to the office in the clubrooms after each game. These cards should show the result of the game, your team goal scorers and the MVP from the opposite team. Do not vote for your own players as this award is presented to the player rated as the best by opposition coaches. The draws for the day are all online – the scores will be uploaded throughout the day.
- + All games will run for 12 minutes each way, with 2 minutes for half time. All games will run to the sound of the hooter.
- + **IMPORTANT:** Car parking is always an issue in and around Endeavour Park during the tournament. There are a number of streets such as Samwell, and Saunders Close that have walking access down into the park which are also good options to avoid the congestion in Albatross Close.

Please **DO NOT** park over people's driveways (or so close that they have trouble getting in and out) and do not move the cones. The Police and Porirua City Council are aware of the tournament and will be constantly monitoring over the weekend and will not hesitate to ticket or tow away offending vehicles.

- + Hot food and cold drinks will be available from the clubrooms. BBQs will be located at the foot of the main stairs into the clubrooms, and in the centre of the Endeavour Park. Please help support our club by using these facilities.

Please note that portable BBQs are not permitted on Endeavour Park for Health and Safety reasons.

- + Endeavour Park has been designated a "No Smoking/No Alcohol" zone by Porirua City Council. It would be appreciated if you could ask your parents to respect this.
- + Please use the rubbish bins which will be located around the field. It makes our life a lot easier at the end of the day if we don't have to go around collecting rubbish!
- + We will have a First Aider on duty both days – should you need assistance please speak to the person on the balcony at the Club rooms who will notify the first aider over the loud speaker. A first aid kit and ice are also available in the clubrooms.
- + Toilets are located both in the clubrooms and in the changing rooms downstairs. Could we please ask that muddy shoes/boots be removed before entering the clubrooms.

Please be aware this is our clubs major fundraiser and we ask other clubs and players to please respect this and not bring their own fundraising items to the park to sell.
